

Studio Etiquette

- **Arrive to class prepared.** This includes being ready to dance, dressed appropriately (following the Dress Code), with hair secured at the noted class time. Be sure to use the bathroom before class—leaving in the middle of class is not acceptable.
- **Tardiness is not acceptable.** Students who arrive more than 10 minutes late will not be permitted to dance. Late students may observe class. This is for the safety of the student: missing the warm-up can result in injury.
- **Attendance is important.** Please attend every class. Excessive absence may result in the student being unable to perform in the show. Missing classes may also cause the student to fall behind in technique.
- **Always have a positive attitude!** Give 100% effort, and practice, practice, practice! Outside practice and review is expected from every student.
- **Wait quietly in the lobby.** Excessive noise distracts the students in class. Use the time before class to begin stretching and warming up in the dressing room or lobby.
- **Students may not leave the studio without a parent.** Parents, please make every effort to arrive promptly to pick up students.
- **Please show respect to all faculty, staff, students, and parents!** We will end all classes with a reverence to the teacher, which signifies the end of class.
